Membership is priced on a banded model based on the number of students. (This will be the latest UK student numbers (headcount) as published by HESA or the Higher Education Students Early Statistics (HESES) survey, as appropriate.)

In England, membership of QAA is voluntary, and our work to enhance quality and protect standards is funded solely through membership fees. QAA Membership is entirely separate from the statutory review work we undertake as the Designated Quality Body appointed under the provisions of the Higher Education and Research Act 2017.
