This resource has been produced to help students understand credit better and equip them with the knowledge to have meaningful conversations about credit, what it is and what it means for them.

Supporting the student experience

QAA funds a number of Collaborative Enhancement Projects (CEPs) specifically focused on enhancing the student experience and approaches to improving student engagement. These projects play an important role in bringing members together to improve student retention and attainment; student representation and student voice; and inclusive and effective student engagement.

Following the publication of the [2024 edition of the UK Quality Code for Higher Education](#) (the Quality Code), QAA is currently working with the sector to develop underpinning Advice and Guidance documents to support providers to meet the 12 Principles of the Quality Code – with the first three sections to be completed in 2024-25. In this first tranche, we will consider the quality and enhancement considerations associated with Principle 2: Engaging students as partners. The updated Advice and Guidance will be published in July 2025.
