Annual Monitoring: Desk-based assessment

International College at Robert Gordon University (Navitas) January 2026

Outcome

1 From the annual return and documentary evidence, the monitoring team concludes that **International College at Robert Gordon University (Navitas)** (the College) is making **acceptable** progress on the implementation of their action plan.

Monitoring summary

2 The College continues to work effectively with Robert Gordon University (the University) and Navitas UK Holdings Ltd to maintain academic standards and the quality of student learning opportunities since the Educational Oversight Review of February 2025. No material changes have been identified, and student recruitment so far in 2025-26 is in line with previous years.

3 The review of 2025 identified good practice (extensive individual support for students and the close relationship between College and University staff) and two recommendations for enhancement. The annual return describes further actions to enhance this area of good practice, and the associated action plan shows that these have either been successfully implemented or are ongoing, with implementation in the coming months. These actions include one-to-one meetings with every student each semester and joint College/University transition events.

4 For Recommendation 1 (clarification of wording on complaints in Admissions Policy), the necessary actions have been completed, and the revised Admissions Policy has been published. For Recommendation 2 (Staff knowledge and understanding of neurodiversity), a programme of actions is underway and due for completion before the report deadline of September 2026. The actions include a rollout of neurodiversity training for all staff as well as key staff attendance at relevant specific training courses. There is also a support network for neurodivergent staff across the Navitas group.

5 In the commentary on the annual report and in the supporting evidence, there is clear evidence of effective quality assurance and enhancement activity. The partnership between the College, the University and Navitas UK Holdings Ltd is effective, and the College continues to use its quality reporting mechanisms to monitor and enhance its provision.
